





NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO HAMPTON CITIZENS

On Wednesday, the 12th day of January 2022, the City Council ("Council") of the City of Hampton, Virginia, will conduct a public hearing on the issuance of general obligation public improvement bonds of the City of Hampton in the estimated maximum principal amount of \$138,000,000 to finance the cost of various capital improvement projects. The projects include, but are not limited to, additions and/or improvements to public buildings, facilities for public safety, public roads, storm water and other public infrastructure, public school facilities, park and recreation facilities and the acquisition of land and equipment for public purposes. The projects to be funded or reimbursed that are expected to use more than ten percent (10%) of the bond funds are the Hampton City Schools General Maintenance and Technology Investment projects estimated at \$29,575,000. The resolution, if adopted, will authorize the Director of Finance, with the approval of the City Manager, for and on behalf of the City, to sell such bonds for such purposes, and to provide for the form, details and payment of the bonds.

The public hearing on the issuance of the bonds for the capital improvement projects will be conducted at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers on the 8th floor of City Hall, 22 Lincoln Street, Hampton, Virginia. Interested persons may appear at such time and place and present their views.

Information on the above item may be obtained from the Director of Finance by calling 757-727-6230 and the Clerk of Council.

All interested persons will be heard at the above stated time and place.

The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain public comment on the item listed above. The governing body shall permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present oral testimony and, pursuant to Chapter 2 of the Code of the City of Hampton, has established a time limit of three (3) minutes per speaker.

The City of Hampton is in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. If you will require an accommodation or sign language interpreter to participate in the meeting, reasonable accommodations can be made upon request. Please make requests to the Clerk of Council at least five (5) days in advance of the meeting at 727-6315.
