WHEREAS: the proposed marina use includes the potential for expanding accessory

uses, including parking, related to the existing marina facility but does not

include new boat slips;

WHEREAS: the property is zoned Downtown Waterfront (DT-2) District, which allows for

a marina with an approved use permit;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) recommends mixed

use for the site and provides policies calling for promoting boating access and water uses, promoting public access to the water, and encouraging

further development of boat launching and docking facilities;

WHEREAS: the <u>Downtown Master Plan</u> (2004, as amended) recommends that any

reuse of the marina properties be compatible with the surrounding neighborhood and that Downtown should be connected to the

waterfront;

WHEREAS: staff recommends seven (7) conditions be attached to the use permit

addressing, among other things, operation of the site, requirements for

constructing a new building, parking, and landscaping; and

WHEREAS: one member of the public spoke on this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Christopher Carter and seconded by

Commissioner Ruthann Kellum,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council

approval of Use Permit Application No. 17-00008, subject to seven (7)
