

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2024 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day City Code Amendment No. 24-0469 by the City of Hampton to amend and re-enact Chapter 35.1, entitled "Site Plans", to update and correct cross-references to the Stormwater Management and Erosion Control ordinance;

WHEREAS: on June 22, 2023, the State Water Control Board approved and adopted the Virginia Erosion and Stormwater Management Regulation, which required local governments to consolidate their stormwater management and erosion control ordinances;

WHEREAS: on September 11, 2024, in order to comply with the above-mentioned regulation, City Council adopted the Stormwater Management and Erosion Control ("SMEC") Ordinance;

WHEREAS: in adopting the SMEC Ordinance, City Council repealed City Code Chapter 13.1 – Land Disturbing Operations and City Code Chapter 33.2 – Stormwater Management, and further adopted and enacted City Code Chapter 33.3 – Stormwater Management and Erosion Control;

WHEREAS: the proposed City Code Amendment removes cross-references in the Site Plan Ordinance to former City Code Chapters 13.1 and 33.2, and replaces them with cross-references to new City Code Chapter 33.3;

WHEREAS: no comments or questions were raised by the Commissioners regarding this amendment; and

WHEREAS: no members from the public spoke during the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Tracy Brooks and seconded by Commissioner Ruthann Kellum,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of City Code Amendment No. 24-0469.
