Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program

- Primary objective is the development of viable urban communities by providing:
 - Decent housing
 - A suitable living environment
 - Expand economic opportunity
- Activities must meet one of three national objectives:
 - Benefit low- and moderate-income persons
 - Aid in the prevention of slums and blight
 - Meet an <u>urgent</u> need



HOME Investment Partnership Program

- Primary objective is to:
 - Expand affordable housing opportunities
 - Expand the capacity of non-profit community-based housing development organizations (CHDO's)
 - Strengthen the ability of local governments to provide housing
- Matching Funds: 25% local match
- Non-Profit Participation: 15% CHDO set-aside


