Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Hampton. Virginia By Amending Chapter 2, Section 2-2 Entitled, "Definitions" To Amend The Existing Definitions Of "Bed and Breakfast 1" And "Bed and Breakfast 2" To Clarify How The Use Operates And To Consolidate To A Singular Definition WHEREAS, the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice so require; BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia that Chapter 2, Section 2-2 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia, be amended and re-enacted as follows: Chapter 2 – DEFINITIONS . . . Sec. 2-2. – Definitions. Bed and breakfast 4. A building or portion thereof containing not more than nine (9) sleeping rooms, in which room and board are offered to transient residents by on-site management who are present at all times while there are transient residents. Such operations are open to the general public for the purposes of conducting business during established hours of operation, and may include events. Bed and Breakfast 2 A building or portion thereof containing not more than nine (9) sleeping rooms, in which room and board are offered to transient residents, and in which events may be held. . . .
