Franciscus Homes, Inc. to rezone 7.6+ acres at 960, 1014, 1018, and 1020 Big Bethel Road [LRSN: 4001445, 4001446, 4001447, 4001448] to Multiple

Dwelling (MD-2) District with proffered conditions;

WHEREAS: the property is currently zoned Limited Commercial (C-2) District with

conditions and One Family Residence (R-11) District;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) recommends low

density residential land use and mixed use;

WHEREAS: the <u>Hampton Community Plan</u> recognizes Big Bethel Road as a residential

corridor with commercial nodes;

WHEREAS: the <u>Hampton Community Plan</u> also promotes the efficient use of land, a

diverse mix of housing types, high quality design, treating residential streets as both public rights-of-way and neighborhood amenities, and

safeguarding the integrity of existing residential neighborhoods:

WHEREAS: fifteen (15) proffered conditions include a conceptual layout with onsite

amenities for residents, elevations, and building materials, limiting development to 75 residential units with each building containing up to five units, privacy and decorative fencing, and upgrading the signal at

the intersection of Big Bethel Road and Old Big Bethel Road;

WHEREAS: one member of the public spoke against this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Gaynette LaRue and seconded by

Commissioner Carlton Campbell,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Rezoning Application No. 15-00006, subject to fifteen (15)

proffered conditions.
