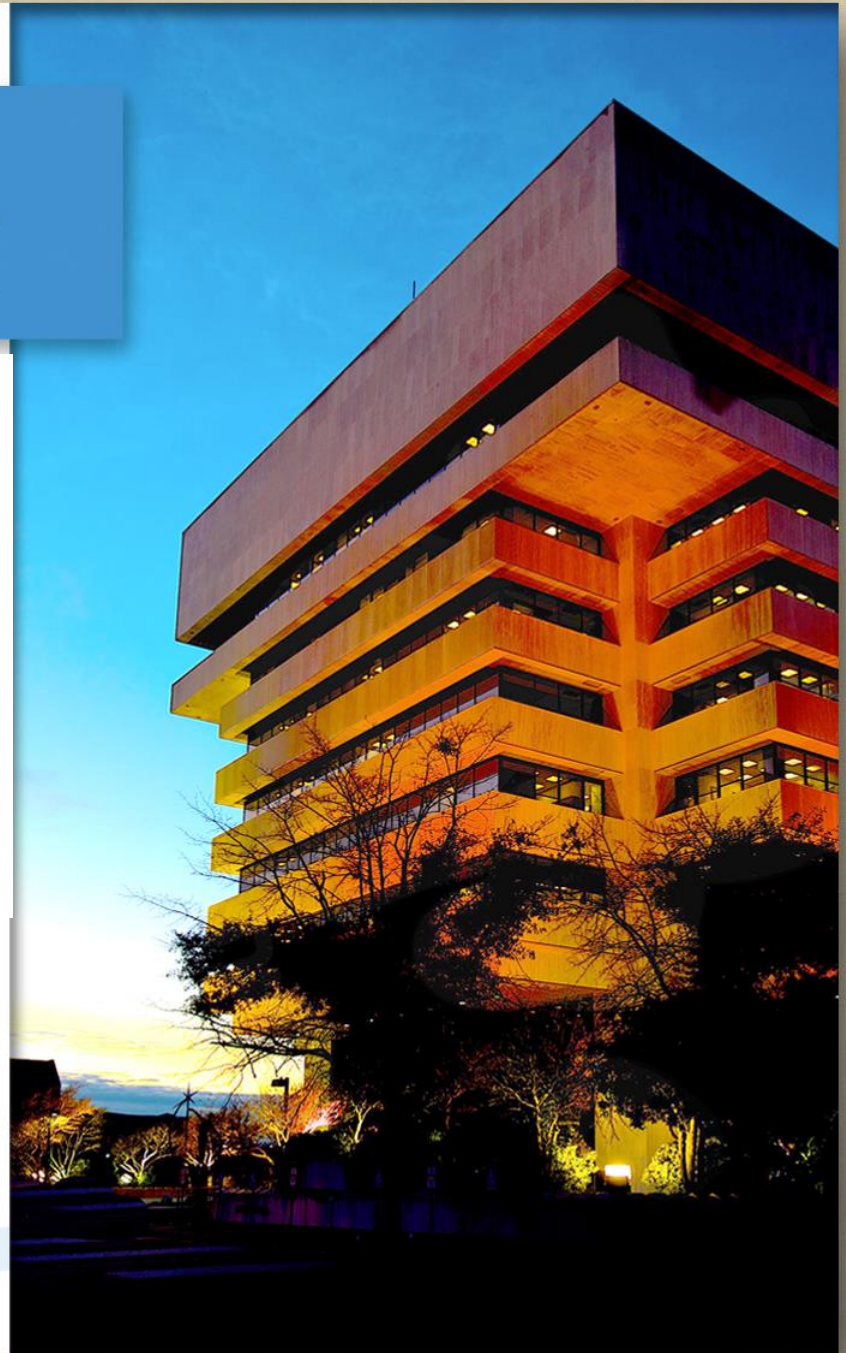

- VDOT – Hampton Road Bridge Tunnel Expansion Project Impacts

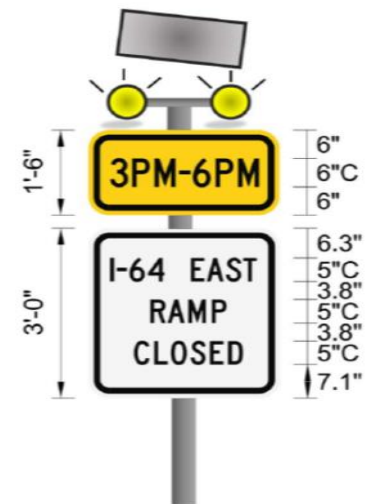


# Hampton Adjustments from 2019 to 2021

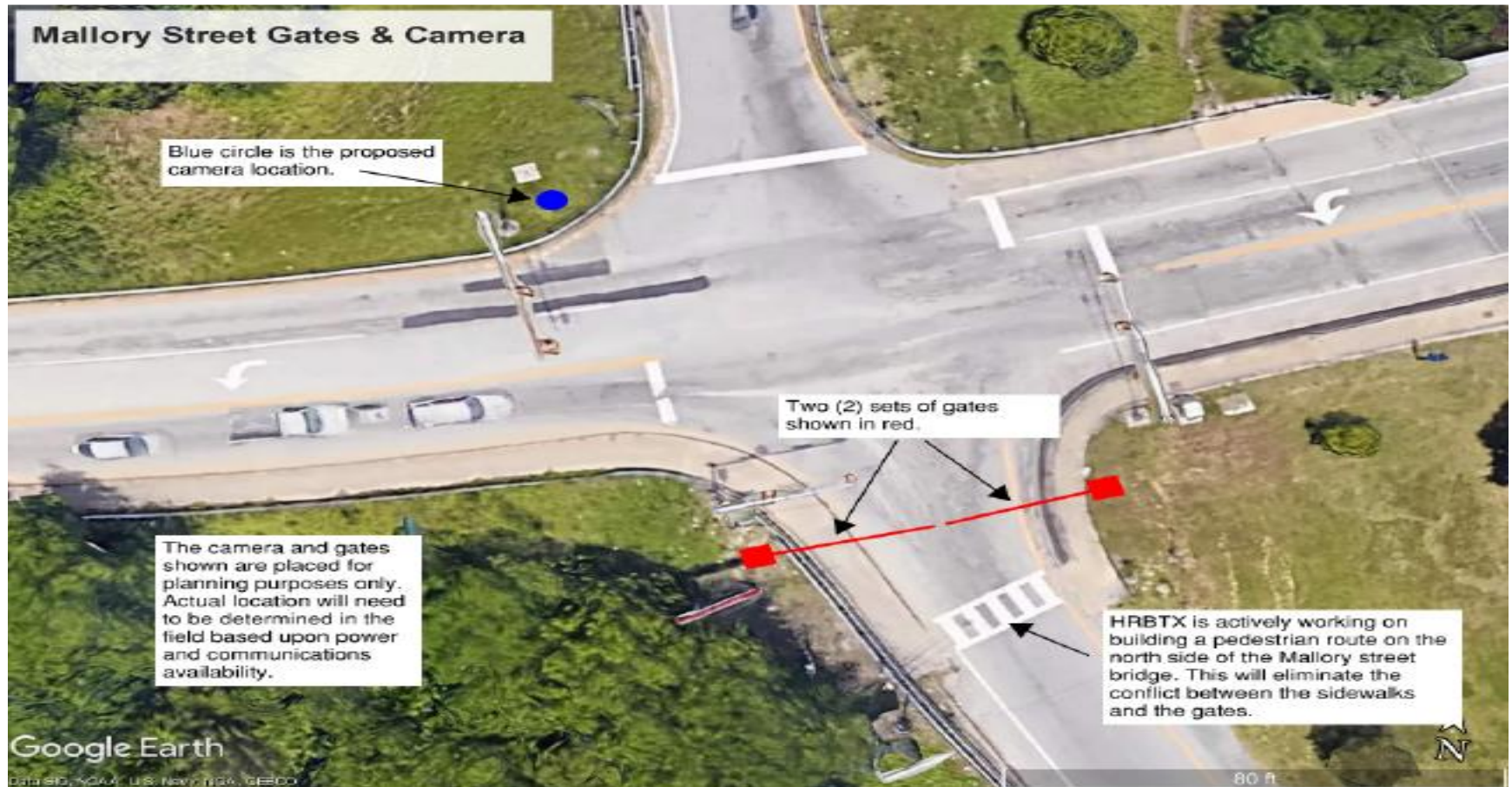
- Installed travel lane delineators on the Settlers Landing Bridge to align traffic with the I-64 eastbound entrance ramp
- Installed “Do Not Block the Box” traffic control measures at intersections in Downtown Hampton and Phoebus impacted by the I-64 congestion
- Installed “No Turn Signs” M-F from 2:00 to 6:00 pm on many streets impacted by I-64 cut through traffic in Phoebus

# Considerations

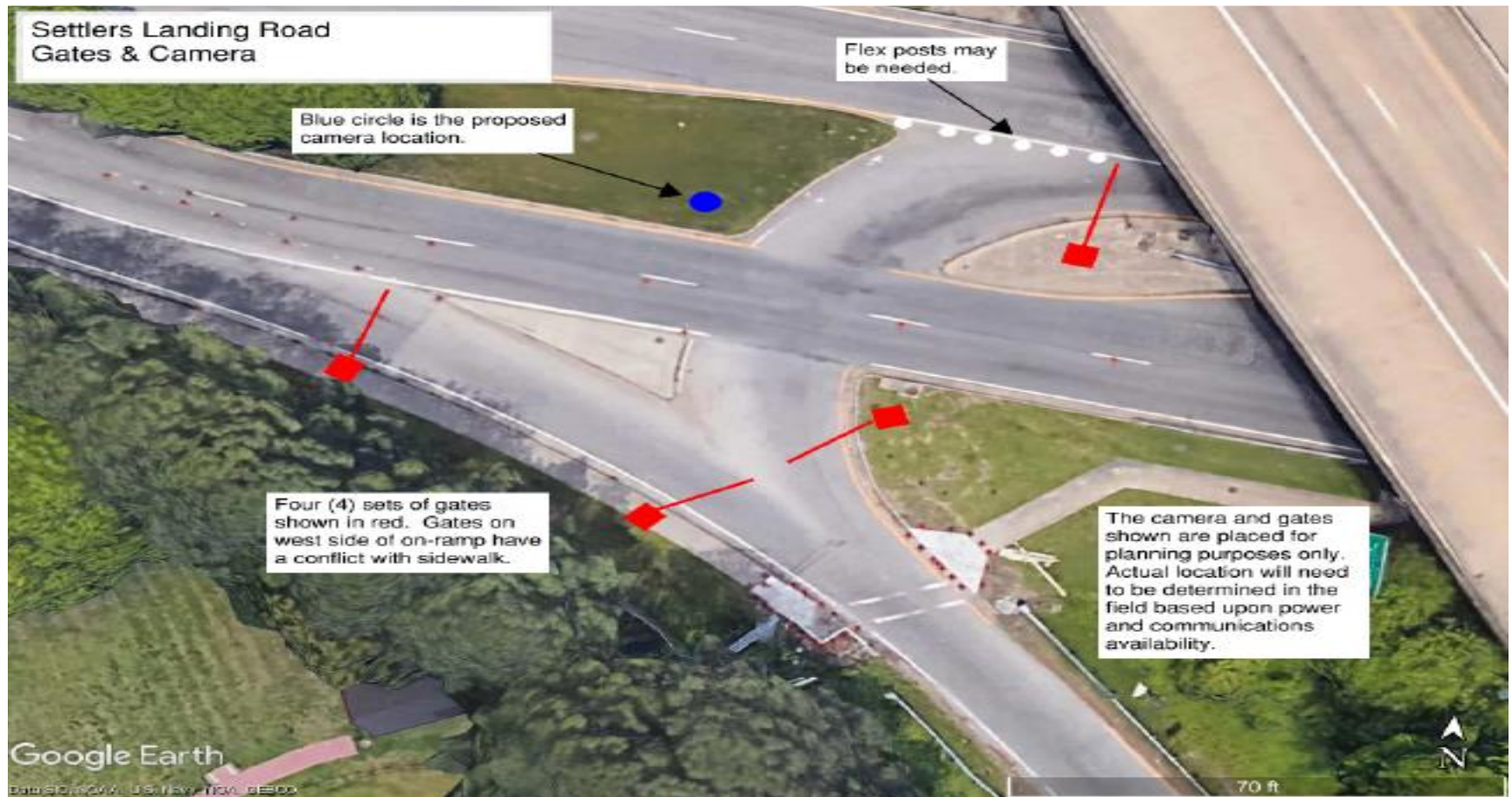
- Proposing limited ramp closures of the Eastbound I-64 ramps at Mallory Street and Settlers Landing Road from 3:00 to 6:00 pm daily to reduce traffic congestion
