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# In Virginia

There are an estimated 150,000 adults aged 65 or older currently living with Alzheimer's disease in Virginia. This number is expected to rise to 190,000 by 2025 (Alzheimer's Association, 2019a). In Hampton, approximately 14.8% (3,200) age 65+ (21,800) have Alzheimer's Dementia.

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

# LAYOUT of MEMORY CARE ALF 13,000 SQUARE FEET




PROJECT NORTH ELEVATION




PROJECT SOUTH ELEVATION
