This Court FURTHER ORDERS that the Secretary of the Electoral Board of the City of Hampton, Virginia, in accordance with Section 24.2-683 of the Code of Virginia, post a copy of this Writ of Election on the official website of the City of Hampton, and have the notice of this special election published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Hampton at least ten (10) days before the special election takes place on November 5, 2024.

FURTHER, that the CLERK is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this Writ of Election to the Secretary of the Electoral Board (Matthew Scott, Office of the Registrar for the City of Hampton, 101 Kings Way, Hampton, Virginia 23669), the Secretary of the Virginia State Board of Elections (Georgia Alvis-Long, Virginia State Board of Elections, Washington Building, 1100 Bank Street, First Floor, Richmond, Virginia 23219), and counsel for the Petitioner.

This matter shall be stricken from the docket.
