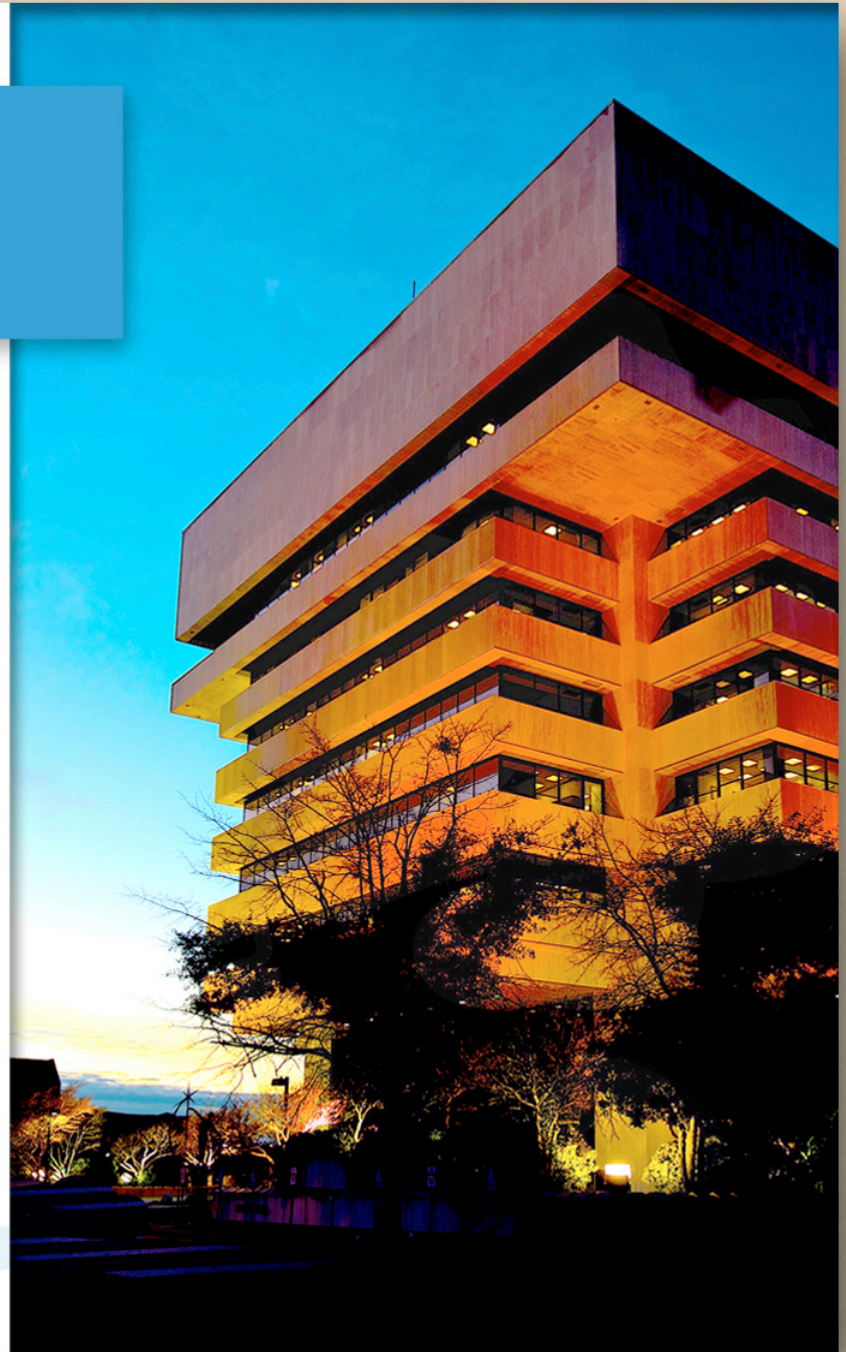

New VDOT Funded Hampton Projects in the Six Year Improvement Plan (SYIP)

July 11, 2018



Overview

- Funding has been allocated for 12 new projects in VDOT's FY19-24 SYIP with Federal and State funds
 - All Reimbursement programs
- VDOT requires a City Council Resolution to program these new projects and authorize City Manager to execute project agreements
- Projects are from four (4) VDOT Programs:
 - Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TA)
 - Revenue Sharing
 - Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)
 - Primary Extension Program

Transportation Alternatives

Mellen Street Bike & Pedestrian Improvements

Scope:

- Improve existing bike and pedestrian facilities on Mellen Street

Limits:

- From Willard Road
- To Mallory Street

Total Cost:

\$442,000 (79% Federal/21% City) \$141,772 in FY19 and \$300,228 in FY20.



Transportation Alternatives

Mercury Boulevard Road Diet & Improvements - Segment I

Scope:

Install new ADA sidewalks, bike lanes, parking lanes

Limits:

- From Mallory Street
- To Willard Road

Total Cost: \$594,000 (80% Federal/20% City) \$175,949 in FY19 and \$418,051 in FY20



Transportation Alternatives

Mercury Boulevard Road Diet & Improvements - Segment II

Scope:

Install new ADA sidewalks, bike lanes, parking lanes

Limits:

- From Willard Road
- To Ft. Monroe

Total Cost: \$298,000 (80% Federal/20% City) \$111,392 in FY19 and \$186,608 in FY20
