Understanding the unique nature of governmental 20 *(*7*)* uses, the zoning administrator may grant parking credits to property 21 22 used for governmental purposes and either owned or leased by the City of Hampton. Governmental purposes shall include, but shall not be 23 24 limited to, city services, community and recreational uses. The applicant 25 requesting such credits shall submit a parking plan and supporting 26 documentation relevant to the specific site and proposed uses. Other 27 relevant data may also be requested of the applicant and/or local, state, and federal agencies. All such information shall be reviewed by the 28 29 director of public works and the community development department director and a recommendation forwarded to the zoning administrator for 30 review. The parking credit request shall be reviewed in accordance with 31 the following criteria: 32 33 34 (a) The health, safety, and public welfare of the community; 35 (b) Consistency with the goals and objectives adopted in the City 36 37 Hampton comprehensive plan, including resiliency goals; 38 39 (c) Availability of pedestrian access and connections; 40 41 Reduced stormwater impacts and minimized excessive parking (d) 42 and the associated environmental impacts;
