

Salt Ponds Inlet Improvements Update March 28, 2018



Background

- In 1979, the North Jetty was constructed and the channel dredged.
- The channel has been dredged 16 times since then including the recently completed project.
- In 1998, a geotube was installed to assist in the establishment of a vegetated sand dune and reduce the risk of erosion and protect the adjacent properties.




SALT PONDS BEACH AND INLET IMPROVEMENTS



Path Forward

- Design and permitting is underway for the improvements of both the north and south jetties.
- The proposed CIP includes funding in FY19 for the cost of the improvements to both jetties.
- The City's consultant will continue to perform yearly surveys to monitor the channel.
- The City is still obligated to dredge the channel on an ongoing basis and will need to identify funding in future fiscal years beginning in FY20
