The city manager, city attorney, deputy city managers, assistant city managers, assistants to the city manager, council appointees, and all certain department heads or equivalents as determined by the city manager, which include but may not be limited to the chief of police, fire chief, and economic development director, shall maintain principal residence within the city during their tenure in such office or employment. When required, this residency requirement shall be met as soon as practical but no later than twelve (12) months subsequent to the commencement of employment in the affected position. The city manager is authorized to make exceptions to this requirement for positions appointed by him only in the event of demonstrated hardship or shortage of qualified applicants.
