Hampton Roads Transit is On the Move

Improving Service Hours & Frequency

15-minute service was launched on Routes 112 in October and 114 in May. Both routes have seen ridership growth.

New Buses

HRT received 24 new buses allocated for 757 Express expansion. Additional buses will be received later this summer.

Expanding & Upgrading Passenger Amenities

620 bus stops will be upgraded with a shelter, bench, or both. 47 shelters have been installed in Hampton since 2021. Another 7 shelters are scheduled to be installed in Hampton within the next 90 days.

Deploying Next-Gen Technologies

HRT launched Real-Time Bus functionality and is working on its mobile fare collection system to include mobile ticketing.

Upgrading Major Transfer Centers

HRT cut a ribbon on the exterior improvements to the Hampton Transit Center in May 2023.

Investing in Our Workforce

As HRT continues to build its workforce, the agency has increased base salaries for frontline workers and is offering service bonuses for qualified candidates.



After a successful 6-month pilot in Newport News and Virginia Beach, HRT is looking to secure long-term funding that would make microtransit one of its core services.

Expanding Outreach & Ridership Promotions

Customers can ride for free on Transit Equity Day (Feb), Earth Day (Apr), Juneteenth (Jun) and Election Day (Nov).







Transit Means Business

Better Reliability, Faster Commutes, New Connections

-60% of HRT customers use transit to get to/from work.

-This includes major employment destinations, such as Newport News Shipbuilding, Naval Station Norfolk & Sentara.

-As HRT continues to expand routes, we will have seen a 127% increase in the number of jobs served by transit.

-While you may never ride Hampton Roads Transit, chances are you depend on someone who does.

- Current Bus Service in the City of Hampton
 - 15 bus routes
 - Level of service 7 days per week, Monday through Friday from 5:00 a.m. until 1:30
 a.m., Saturday from 5:15 a.m. until 12:30 a.m. and Sunday from 5:45 a.m. until 12:30
 a.m.
 - In FY2023 these routes carried 1,028,951 passengers


Hampton Service Changes

FY 2024 Service Changes

- On November 12th, Route 115 is realigned to be a combination of three routes, Route 115, 117 and 120. This change will improve connections in Hampton.
 - Weekday span will begin at 5:17 a.m. midnight
 - Saturday span 6:17 a.m. 10:00 p.m.
 - Sunday Span 8:17 a.m. 8:00 p.m.
- Route 117 and 120 are eliminated.



Route 112


757 Express service (all improvements paid for by HRRTF)

- 15-minute service is provided during peak periods between 6th and Ivy and Patrick Henry Mall with a stop at Orcutt Avenue and 81st Street Monday through Friday.
- 30-minute service is provided to Lee Hall from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Weekday span was improved to 5:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. and Sunday span improved to 5:15 a.m. to 12:30 a.m.

FY 2031

 Improve weekday midday, Saturday base, and Sunday baseheadways to 30-minutes.


757 Express service (all improvements paid for by HRRTF)

 Improve weekday midday, Saturday base, and Sunday baseheadways to 30-minutes.






Routes 112 and 114 Ridership
