

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 20, 2018 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day an Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact Chapter 3 Of The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Hampton, Virginia Entitled "Uses Permitted" By Amending Section 3-3 Pertaining to Additional Standards For Live Entertainment;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) identifies policies that support retail and entertainment venues;

WHEREAS: the proposed amendment amends the additional standards placed on the Live Entertainment 1 use including limiting it to venues with no dance floor or similar space, performance areas of 75 square feet or less, allowing live entertainment indoors only, set hours of operation, compliance with City Code relative to noise, compliance with all applicable federal and state laws, and a review of permit after 12 months of operations;

WHEREAS: Live Entertainment 1 will no longer be defined by occupancy;

WHEREAS: venues not meeting the definition of Live Entertainment 1 or wanting to operate outside the additional standards would be considered Live Entertainment 2 and require a use permit where allowed;

WHEREAS: this amendment is part of a package of amendments to redefine Live Entertainment 1 and Live Entertainment 2 and better facilitate the operation of live entertainment in the City; and

WHEREAS: no members of the public spoke on this proposal.


NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Mary Bunting and seconded by Commissioner Ruthann Kellum,
