**WHEREAS:** the Ham

the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day Zoning Ordinance Amendment No. 24-0176 by the City of Hampton to amend and re-enact the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia by amending Chapter 9 entitled, "Overlay Districts" to add Article VIII, entitled "O-STR – Short-term Rental Overlay" which will establish short-term rental zones throughout the City of Hampton;

WHEREAS: the proposed overlay will establish a maximum number of permitted short-

term rentals for each short-term rental zone, and establish a required

separation between short-term rentals;

WHEREAS: this proposed amendment seeks to balance the dispersion of short-term

rentals throughout the city in a manner that maintains the character of

neighborhoods while suitably balancing the entrepreneurial spirit of the use;

WHEREAS: this amendment is brought in conjunction with Zoning Ordinance

Amendments 24-0173, 24-0174, 24-0175, and 24-0177 which will together establish new restrictions on how and where short-term rentals within the

City can operate, and will clarify other similar uses;

WHEREAS: Commissioners Coleman, Kellum, and Harris raised concerns that the

separation and density limits in the Buckroe area may be too restrictive, and Commissioner Rogers spoke in favor of treating Buckroe similar to other

areas of the City; and

**WHEREAS:** 34 members from the public spoke during the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Brian DeProfio and seconded by

Commissioner Kathy Rogers,

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Zoning Ordinance Amendment No. 24-0176 with an effective

date of July 1, 2024.
