Chapter 5 - ANIMALS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia, that Chapter 5 of the 5 City Code of the City of Hampton, Virginia be amended to read as follows:

(u) _ ugu	It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any dog owned or kept by him to run
_(' '	or go at large within the city, whether such dog is licensed or not. Any person
	who permits his dog to run at large, or remain unconfined, unrestricted or not
	penned up shall be deemed to have violated the provisions of this section.
(1)	No dog shall run at large in the City of Hampton. Any person who is the owner or
	custodian of a dog found running at large in the City of Hampton shall be in
	violation of this section.
(2)	The first violation of this section shall constitute a Class 4 misdemeanor. The
	second violation on the same animal shall constitute a Class 3 misdemeanor and
	subsequent violations on the same animal shall constitute a Class 2
	misdemeanor. Any owner cited for three (3) violations of this section, may have
	his animals impounded or spayed and neutered at the owner's or custodian's
	expense.

(3)	A violation of this subsection (a) shall constitute a Class 2 misdemeanor if the
	dog, while at large within the city, attacks a human being or another animal
	without provocation. If the Court finds the evidence sufficient to convict the dog's
	owner or caretaker under this subsection, the court may order the owner or
	custodian to pay restitution for actual damages to any person injured by the animal or whose companion animal was injured or killed by the animal.

(4)	This section shall not apply to any person while engaged in law enforcement or
(+)	search and rescue activity; in a supervised formal obedience training class or
	show; during formally sanctioned field trials; while engaged in lawful hunting with a
