As medical professionals, we understand that time is tissue. Any delay in CPR, defibrillation, and definitive care lessens the chance of survivability. This mobile platform increases the possibility of civic engamenent in these cases and provides situational awareness to other incidents that may be of interest to the community.

In addition to the potential benefits of increasing community outreach and involvement, the application could also provide benefits to our organization with regard to early notification and awareness about incidents in our respective localities and during mutual aid responses. Although Hampton has an excellent response time to all locations within the city, every second counts. Currently, the cities of Chespaeake, Newport News, and Norfolk use the application, and James City County, York County, and Williamsburg are in the process of coming on board with *PulsePoint*. The more agencies that are able to share in this technology, the more our agencies can work together to make a difference.
