Narrative Statement

HISTORY

The subject property is a part of property acquired in July 1996. A portion of the property including the "Richardson house" was sold in September 1996 leaving the subject parcel. This property was included in a use permit application (#915) filed in 1997 requesting expansion of slips into the riparian rights and construction of overflow parking on the lot. After indication from the neighborhood residents that additional off-street parking was not needed the application was amended by deleting the parking element. The use permit was approved at the May 28, 1997 Council meeting.

EXISTING USE

The property is an approximately rectangular 0.43 acre parcel bounded 90.00'on the North by Victoria Blvd. and 174.60' by property of Hampton Yacht Club, on the East 70.85' by property of Hampton Yacht Club, on the South 274.85' by property of John D. and Jean Blackburn and on the West 70.15'by Bridge Street. The property is zoned R-13 Single family residential and is currently vacant.

PROPOSED USES

The Hampton Yacht Club has an active small boat sailing program including a community wide Junior program, High school sailing program and similar related activities. The Club is requesting the right to extend the Marina use designation to the subject property to allow the small boat program to improve its outreach, training and instructional activities including small boat regattas. To that extent:

- No buildings are anticipated. Structures will be limited to security fencing similar in design and construction to the 6' architectural fencing located elsewhere on Club property. Boat storage will be limited to seasonal storage of small boats as required to support the ongoing programs.
- -No additional employees are anticipated
- -The proposed use will serve the existing small boat sailing activities including the Junior program, high school sailing program and similar activities. Operational hours are daytime.
- -Off-street parking, as required, is located on adjacent Yacht Club property to the North.
- -Access is provided via Victoria Blvd., Bridge Street and circulation through the existing yacht Club parking facilities
- -Ownership and management is provided by the Hampton Yacht Club management staff with oversight by the Board of Directors
- -The requested use will not impact public services.
