

1 **Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact Article 1 Of Chapter 10 Of The Zoning Ordinance Of**
2 **The City Of Hampton, Virginia Entitled “Signs” By Amending Section 10-5 Pertaining To**
3 **Signs Exempt From Regulation In This Ordinance.**

5 **Whereas**, the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice so
6 require;

8 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia that chapter 10 of the Zoning
9 Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia, be amended and re-enacted as follows:

11 **CHAPTER 10 – SIGNS**

13 **ARTICLE 1 – GENERAL REGULATIONS**

15 **Sec. 10-5. – Signs exempt from regulation in this ordinance.**

17 (1) Official historic markers.

18 ...

19 (10) Temporary special event signs. For purposes of this section, temporary special
20 event signs shall mean signs authorized by a Special Event Permit issued
21 pursuant to Chapter 26 of the Hampton City Code.

22 *(11) Menu display signs.*

23 *(a) Establishments with outdoor seating areas will be permitted one (1) menu*
24 *display sign within the designated outdoor seating area.*

25 *(b) Signs shall not exceed two (2) square feet in area and four (4) feet in*
26 *height, shall not contain lighting, and shall be movable with flat footing.*

28 **Sec. 10-6. - Nonconforming signs.**
