


Proposal

- No alcohol sales or service

Floor Plan




Zoning Map

- Transform aging, autodominant retail centers into walkable mixed-use districts, containing both residential and commercial uses.
- Implement design strategies to transform Riverdale Plaza into a flexible street and block structure that will allow a range of uses that are responsive to the market in Riverdale Plaza

Analysis

- The proposed Restaurant 3 hours of operation are consistent with typical fast food restaurant operations in the Coliseum Central area
- Existing location and scale of development supports the extended hours of operation

Community Meeting

 Strongly recommended by staff, but to date the applicant has not held a community meeting

Recommended Conditions

- Hours of Operation:
 - General: Sunday Saturday 5:00 AM to 3:00 AM
 - Outdoor Dining: consistent w/dining room hours
- Window Transparency & Privacy
- Capacity
- Alcohol Sales & Service
- Licensing and Compliance with Laws
