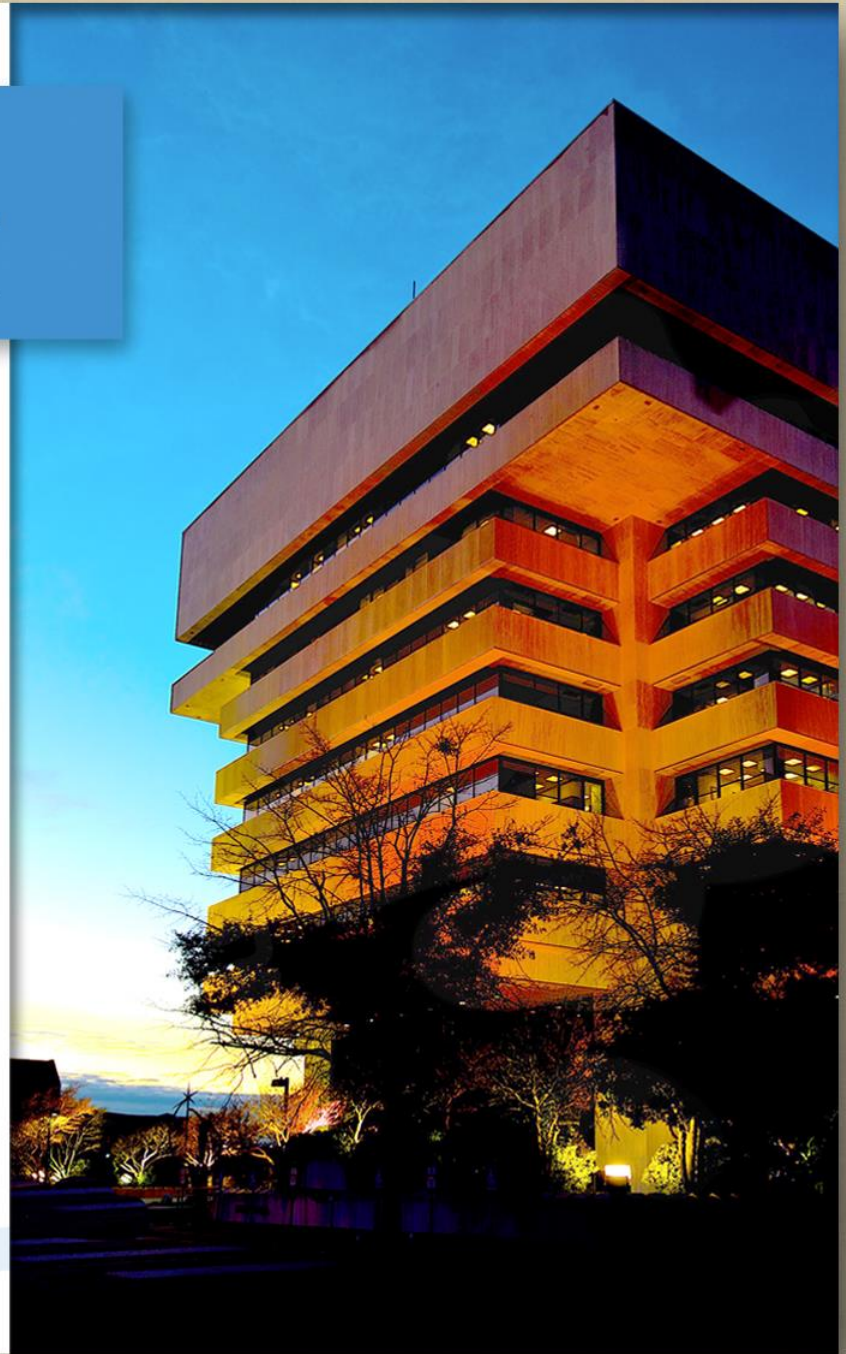


# HAMPTON VA

## **VDOT Urban Formula Reconciliations**

December 13, 2017



# Overview

- **VDOT has just completed a statewide reconciliation of all Urban Funds**
- **\$2.8 M was identified from older Hampton Urban projects. 80% of the funding is Federal; the other 20% is local. If actions are approved, the local match will be submitted as part of the upcoming CIP process.**
- **Staff proposes that these funds be used on two existing urban projects, two existing projects that must be converted to urban projects, and one new urban project**
- **VDOT has requested that we approve resolutions by the end of the year so that projects can be added to the SYIP**
- **VDOT requires a City Council Resolution to program new projects, to Urbanize existing projects and authorize City Manager to execute project agreements; we are requesting this action tonight**

# Existing Urban Projects

## Bridge Street Bridge

### Scope:

- Replace existing obsolete bridge

### Project Limits:

- At bridge only



# Existing Urban Projects

## Todd's Lane at Big Bethel Road

### Scope:

Install new turn lanes, sidewalks, access management, and traffic signals

### Project Limits:

- At intersection only



# Urbanized Projects

## Pine Chapel Road Trail

### Scope:

Install Pedestrian/  
Bicycle Trail

### Project Limits:

From: Coliseum Drive  
To: Bass Pro Entrance



# Urbanized Projects

## N. King Street Streetscape Phase IV

### Scope:

- Provide streetscaping

### Limits:

- From: Lincoln St
- To: Interstate 64



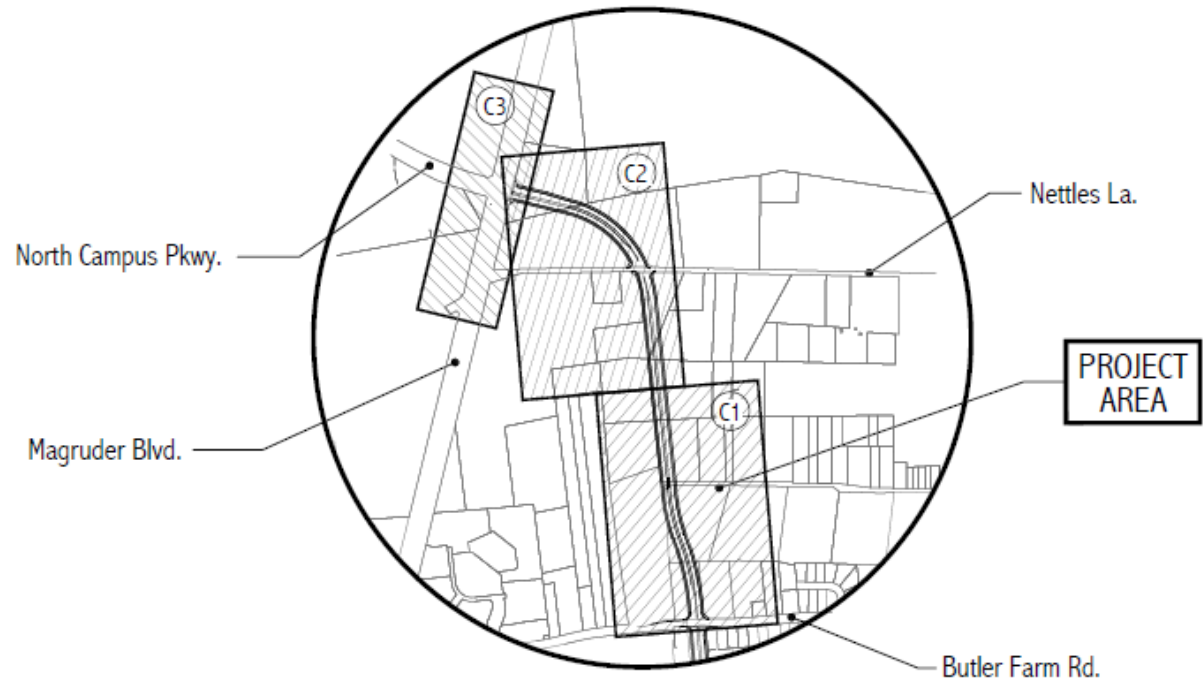
# New Urban Project

- **From: Butler Farm Road**
- **To: Magruder Blvd**

# New Urban Project

## Coliseum Drive Phase B

- Phase A is currently under design; construction scheduled to begin in Spring 2019
- Requested Smart Scale funds in 2016
- Highest ranked project that was not funded in Hampton Roads
- Trying to improve score by adding non-Smart Scale funds to project
- If resolution is approved tonight, staff will request funding again in FY20 application cycle with funds available around FY30

**No resolution is required to provide additional funds for the existing Urban projects.**
