

Summary

- CPP sets forth policies & procedures for citizen participation related to HUD grant planning for entitlement communities
- Originally adopted in January 1995
 & amended in May 1997
 - Dated use of protocols for notification
 - Provided no emergency procedures or electronic public hearings

Proposed Changes

Plan Topics	Current Plan	Proposed Changes
Public Hearing	Required at least two public hearings annually	Clarifies public hearings will take place prior Council approval of Annual Actional Plan and Performance Report
Reasonable Accommodations	Not Addressed	Clarifies that the City follows ADA & other reasonable accommodation requirements
CAPER Public Comment Period	30 days	15 days (per HUD guidelines)
Substantial Amendment	Outdated language	Updated to current statutory requirements
Emergency Procedures	Not addressed	Clarifies that waivers granted by HUD do not require updates to the CPP
Complaint Procedures	Not addressed	Provides procedures for formal complaints regarding HUD programs

- Submit revised CPP to HUD
- HUD Review & Approval
