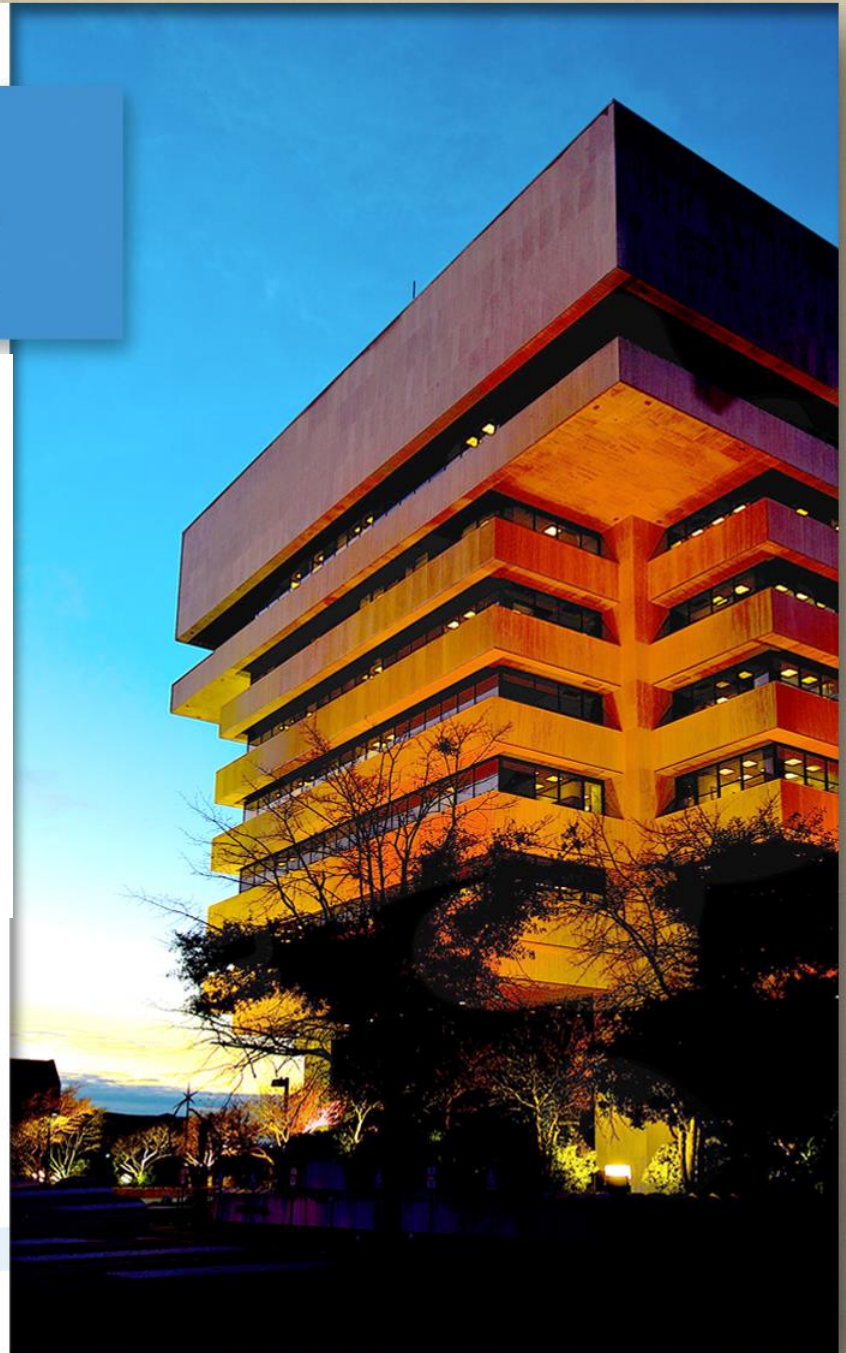

I-64 / HRBT Congestion Concerns

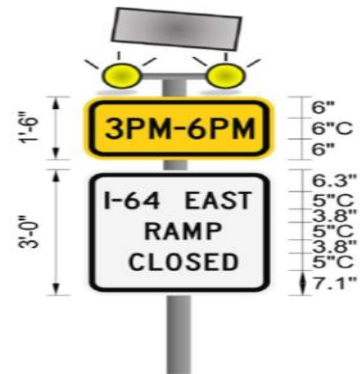
- Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Hampton Road Bridge Tunnel Expansion Project Impacts

- Continue our limited closure of the Mallory Street Bridge entrance

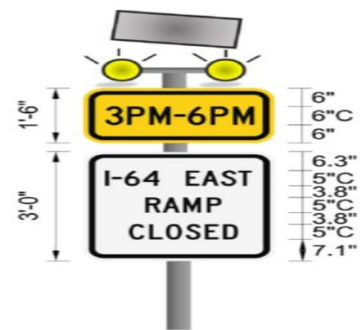
(Monday thru Friday from 3:00pm - 6:00pm)

- Consideration of a limited closure of the Eastbound I-64 access ramp at Settlers Landing Road

(June 1st to 30th - Monday thru Friday from 3:00pm - 6:00pm)

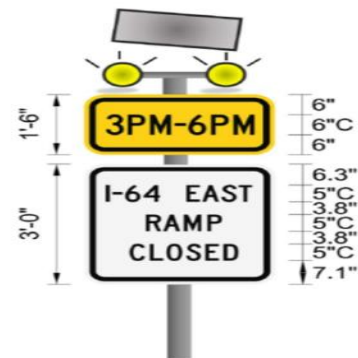

- Consideration of a limited ramp closure of the Eastbound I-64 ramp at Settlers Landing Road (July 1st to 29th - Monday thru Friday from 3:00pm - 6:00pm)

Pilot Projects

- Pilot projects would study the closures for 60 days, and traffic impacts would be evaluated
- **April & May 2022** (Mallory Street Bridge would be restricted to one way traffic by our Hampton Police Department on Monday-Friday from 3:00pm - 6:00pm)
- **June & July 2022** (Settlers Landing E I64 access would be restricted by our Hampton Police Department on Monday-Friday from 3:00pm - 6:00pm)
- Data would be collected to highlight the traffic impacts on Hampton streets as we explore alternate enforcement options and the cost to reduce traffic congestion

Recommendation

- Extend the Mallory Street pilot program for an additional 60 days based on the traffic reductions we currently have in our Phoebus community
- Continue with phase two of our pilot programs at Settlers Landing Road and our evaluation of options to reduce congestion created by the HRBT construction project
- Continue exploring the use of technology to enforce traffic violations (traffic signage, signals & cameras)
- Request that Hampton City Council support our pilot projects to reduce congestion
