Proposal to Alter Voting Precincts in Hampton, VA for future Elections

Eliminate Syms, City Hall, Peake, and Phoebus Library precincts

Combine Syms & half of Smith precincts (voting at Smith)
Combine Peake and Langley Precincts (voting at Langley)
Combine half of Smith and Phoebus (voting at PHS)
Current East Hampton precinct votes at Moton
Combine City Hall with Hampton Library (voting at Hampton Library)
Move Bluebird Gap Farm into Lindsey (no voters effected)
Shift portions of Machen (N. of Cmndr Shepherd Blvd.) to Sandy Bottom
Shift portions of Cooper into half of Machen (voting at Machen)
The rest of Cooper stays at Cooper.

Eliminates 3 precincts saving tax-payer dollars We will need fewer Officers of Elections. There will be a more efficient utilization of Officers of Elections. This requires less equipment to be purchased in the future.

Eliminates problematic locations – Phoebus Library (tiny), City Hall (security risk), Syms (no handicap parking), HU students voting at PHS

No voters change representation (same legislative districts).

Keeps the bigger precincts under the limit for voters (4000) in a Presidential Election for a longer time.
