

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, APRIL 4, 2013 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day a proposal by Richard S. Ayers DBA Attic Tattoos, LLC to permit a tattoo parlor in an existing building at 1073 N. King Street [LRSN 8000678];

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006 as amended) recommends commercial use for this property, encourages an environment that nurtures small and startup businesses, and encourages the clustering of commercial development in an effort to protect residential uses and adjacent neighborhoods;

WHEREAS: the site is currently zoned Limited Commercial (C-2) District which permits a tattoo parlor with an approved Use Permit;

WHEREAS: eight conditions are attached to address hours of operation, screening, compliance with applicable health regulations, and term of permit; and

WHEREAS: no one from the public spoke for or against this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Carlton Campbell and seconded by Commissioner James Young,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Use Permit Application No. 1085-2013, subject to eight (8) conditions.


