

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day an Ordinance to amend and reenact Chapter 2 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia Entitled "Definitions" by amending Section 2-2 – "Definitions";

WHEREAS: this amendment introduces the term "banquet hall" to the Zoning Ordinance and provides a definition;

WHEREAS: banquet hall is defined as "a facility constructed with or without a kitchen, leased for the purpose of hosting private social events not open to the general public, with or without live entertainment, where food and/or drink may be consumed on site"; and

WHEREAS: no one from the public spoke in regards to this proposed amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Gaynette LaRue and seconded by Commissioner Gregory Williams,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Zoning Ordinance Amendment No. 195-2016.
