

Summary of Phase 2 of City Staff Short-Term Rental Stakeholder Engagement

In the Fall of 2023, the Community Development Department (CDD) convened a group of community stakeholders to provide guidance on the second major phase of development of the City's Short-Term Rental (STR) regulations and practices. This group of convened stakeholders functioned as a "focus group" by providing feedback, guidance, and ideas on particular areas of the regulations that needed to be addressed. The scope of the areas that the group was asked to address included: STR density, separation, suitable areas, types of STRs, and the permitting process.

The stakeholder group was comprised of nine (9) members representing diverse perspectives, including those operating and managing STRs, a local Bed and Breakfast operator, and several local neighborhood leaders from a range of geographic areas. The participants included: Kevin Steele, Joyce Blair, Greg Garrett, Connie Vasta, Joe Griffith, Shawn Irving, Jamie Chapman, Glen Barron, and Lynn Howard. As necessary, one (1) to three (3) participants joined via Zoom for each of the meetings.

The CDD staff convened the group weekly beginning on Thursday December 7, 2023 and continuing on Tuesdays beginning on December 12, 2023 and ending on January 30, 2024. The group met for a total of seven (7) sessions from 4:30pm to approximately 6:30pm. A summary of topics and key discussion is outlined below:
