

Current HUD Proposal

- Current proposal for significant cuts to HUD's budget (13% Overall = \$6 Billion)
- Initial proposals would eliminate CDBG/HOME (\$3 Billion, nationally)
- If passed, a significant & lasting impact to neighborhood revitalization, particularly in low to moderate income neighborhoods

OMB Proposed Budget Impact

- Elimination of CDBG/HOME funding
 - Elimination of almost all Affordable Housing development, Homeownership programs, Housing Counseling, & Neighborhood Revitalization initiatives
 - Elimination of dedicated funding for CHDO's (Habitat)
 - Elimination of Fair Housing training & coordination
 - Reprioritization of inspections between Rental Inspection & Property Maintenance Enforcement

OMB Proposed Budget Impact

- Elimination of CDBG/HOME funding
 - Explore change in leadership and volunteer support at Neighborhood Centers
 - Reduction of 40-50% in Neighborhood
 Engagement, Curb Appeal Grant management,
 Home Repair Blitz events, & Community Civic
 Education activities

Next Steps

- City is not poised to pick up significant cuts
 - Approx. \$650,000 in total personnel costs to City/HRHA
- Work with regional agencies to coordinate with legislative contacts & increase awareness
 - Hpt. Roads Housing Consortium
 - Hpt. Roads Community Housing Resources Board
 - Virginia Housing Alliance Federal Housing Day
- Explore other potential alternative resources along with state & outside agencies
- Expected budget impact as early as Oct 2017
