Ordinance To Amend and Reenact Chapter 5 - Animals of the City Code of Hampton,
Virginia By Amending Section 5-2, pertaining to the definition of "at large"

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia, that Chapter 5 of the City Code of the City of Hampton, Virginia be amended to read as follows:

Chapter 5 - ANIMALS

...

Sec. 5-2. - Definitions.

Unless otherwise expressly stated or the content clearly indicates a different intention, the following words and terms shall, for the purposes of this chapter, have the meaning indicated in this section:

17 ...

 At large shall mean roaming, running or self-hunting off the property of its owner or custodian and not under its owner's or custodian's immediate control by leash, rope, or chain attached to a commercial pet collar or harness or contained within a pet carrier, crate or enclosed pet stroller. except that a A dog shall not be considered at large if it is on a bona fide hunt in the city in the company of the hunter; er is off leash in an officially designated Bark Park; or is off leash in a space within a public park defined as an off-leash dog area by the director of parks, recreation and leisure services and identified by signage as available for off-leash dog activity. At large shall not apply to any person while engaged in law enforcement or search and rescue activity; in a supervised formal obedience training class or show; or during formally sanctioned field trials or field dog training.
