

**AT A PUBLIC HEARING AND REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA ON MONDAY, May 14, 2007 AT 3:30 P.M.**

**WHEREAS:** Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day a request to amend Article XII. "Special Public Interest - Buckroe District (SPI-B)" Sec. 17.3-89 "Boundaries" of the City of Hampton Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS:** The current boundaries of Special Public Interest-Buckroe District are explicitly stated in the Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS:** A Zoning Ordinance Amendment would be necessitated by the approval of Rezoning Application No.1224-D which would change the boundaries of the Special Public Interest-Buckroe District by removing 5.69± acres of land currently zoned Special Public Interest-Buckroe District and placing it under the Special Public Interest-Public Land District; and

**WHEREAS:** The Hampton Planning Commission recommends approval of Rezoning Application No.1224-D for the purposes of expanding of Buckroe Park; and

**WHEREAS:** The removal of the 5.69±acres from the Special Public Interest-Buckroe District must be reflected in the text of the Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS:** Three people from the public spoke against this request.


**NOW THEREFORE,** on a motion by Commissioner Amy Thorstad, and seconded by Commissioner Charles Sapp,
