24	The following minimum conditions shall be met:
25 26	(a) No more than four (4) animals be kept, stabled, or pastured for each acre of land so used.
27 28	(b) An accessory building, structure, or use, to include a private stable for the keeping of, or the use of, horses, ponies, or similar equine animals is permitted, provided:
29 30 31 32 33	 (i) That such a stable or such use shall not be permitted on a lot containing less than one (1) acre; if two (2) or more such animals but not exceeding eight (8) are to be kept, a minimum lot area of two (2) acres shall be required; if more than eight (8) such animals are to be kept, a minimum lot area of three (3) acres shall be required; and
34 35 36 37	 (ii) That no structure used as a stable, manure pit, or bin, or yard for the keeping of such equine animals shall be located nearer than sixty (60) feet to any adjacent lot line, except where such lot line abuts a water course at least sixty (60) feet in width.

40 41	(37) Agriculture/farming in the R-R district shall be on a lot with a minimum of three (3) acres.

(a) That no structure or yard for the keeping of any animals, other than as described in Section 1-24(4) be within 100 feet of any property line.
