Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Hampton. Virginia By Amending Chapter 6, Section 6-2 Entitled, "Development Standards In General" To Permit Outdoor Recreation Areas Associated With A Physical Recreational Facility To The List Of Permitted Outdoor Uses In The Neighborhood Commercial (C-1) District WHEREAS, the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice so require; BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia that Section 6-2 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia be amended to read as follows: **CHAPTER 6 – COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS** ... ARTICLE I. - C-1 DISTRICT - NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL Section 6-2. - Development standards in general. (1) Limitations. Permitted stores, shops, offices, or businesses, except food truck host sites, gasoline supply stations, outdoor dining, outdoor play areas associated with a day care center, outdoor recreation areas associated with a physical recreational facility, and parking lots, shall be conducted wholly within an enclosed building and no more than fifty (50) percent of the floor area of any building shall be used for the storage of merchandise.
