

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, MAY 5, 2016 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day an Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact Chapter 2 Of The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Hampton, Virginia Entitled "Definitions" By Amending Section 2-2 Pertaining To Day Cares;

WHEREAS: this amendment would change the definitions of Day Care and bring them into compliance with the State code;

WHEREAS: this amendment is part of a pair of amendments to bring the City of Hampton's Day Care regulations into compliance with State regulations and streamline the Day Care application process;

WHEREAS: this amendment takes effect July 1, 2016; and
