

# Federal Funding CDBG Objectives

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
  - Development of viable urban communities by:
  - providing decent housing,
  - a suitable living environment, and
  - economic opportunity principally for low to moderate income people.
- CDBG's Broad National Objectives
- Benefit to low to moderate income persons,
- Aid in the prevention of slums and blight, or
- Meet an urgent need.

## Federal Funding CDBG Revenues

Anticipated FY2018 Local Allocation: \$1,164,801 Estimated FY2018 Program Income: \$ 25,000

CDBG Reimbursement Allocation: \$ 100,000

CDBG TOTAL: \$1,289,801

# Federal Funding HOME Objectives

#### **HOME Investment Partnership Program**

- 1. Expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing;
- 2. Strengthen the ability of local governments to provide housing; and
- 3. Expand the capacity of non-profit community based housing development organizations.

## Federal Funding HOME Revenues

Anticipated FY2018 Local Allocation: \$372,800 Estimated FY2018 Program Income: \$170,000
