

**AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 20, 2018 AT 3:30 P.M.**

**WHEREAS:** the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day an Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact Chapter 9 Of The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Hampton, Virginia Entitled "Overlay Districts" By Amending Article 3 – Coliseum Central Overlay To Redefine Live Entertainment 1 and Live Entertainment 2;

**WHEREAS:** the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) identifies providing all people with world-class cultural and leisure activities in Hampton as a goal;

**WHEREAS:** the Coliseum Central Master Plan (2006, as amended) identifies Coliseum Central as the core commercial district with entertainment uses;

**WHEREAS:** this amendment defines Live Entertainment 1 venues and modifies additional standards for Live Entertainment 1 to ensure that any impacts of the use to the surrounding areas are minimized;

**WHEREAS:** Live Entertainment 1 applies only to those venues that are providing live entertainment indoors only, have no dance floor or similar space, and have a performance area of 75 square feet or less;

**WHEREAS:** Live Entertainment 1 will no longer be defined by occupancy;

**WHEREAS:** venues not meeting the definition of Live Entertainment 1 or wanting to operate outside the additional standards would be considered Live Entertainment 2 and require a use permit where allowed;

**WHEREAS:** this amendment is part of a package of amendments to redefine Live Entertainment 1 and Live Entertainment 2 and better facilitate the operation of live entertainment in the City; and

**WHEREAS:** no members of the public spoke for or against this amendment.


**NOW, THEREFORE,** on a motion by Commissioner Steven Brown and seconded by Commissioner Trina Coleman,
