WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day a use

permit application by Loretta O'Brien-Parham to permit a short-

term rental in the One-Family Residential (R-13) District;

WHEREAS: the parcel is located at 3808 Chesapeake Ave [LRSN: 2002617] and

zoned R-13 District;

WHEREAS: the property is not currently operating as a short-term rental and

has no active complaints or pending enforcement actions;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) recommends

low-density residential land use for this property. The Plan defines low-density residential as areas with a recommended density range

from 3.5 units to less than 9 units per acre;

WHEREAS: the <u>Kecoughtan Road Corridor Master Plan</u> (2005, as amended)

acknowledges the role of Kecoughtan Road as a primary transportation and commercial corridor during the initial stages of Hampton's development and envisions its present and future function as a redefined neighborhood boulevard that will enhance

and support the overall health of the adjacent neighborhoods;

WHEREAS: fifteen (15) proposed conditions include a limit on overnight

lodging capacity, parking requirements, posting of additional information inside of the dwelling, designation of a responsible local person (RLP), a ledger with guest information, events and gatherings restrictions, inspection stipulations, advertising

requirements, and compliance with Hampton City Code;

**WHEREAS:** City staff recommends approval of this use permit application;

**WHEREAS:** three members of the public expressed opposition to the land use

application due to concerns about permitting short-term rentals in

a primarily residential neighborhood;

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Vice-Chair Steven Bond and seconded by

Commissioner Hope Harper,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City

Council approval of Use Permit Application No. 23-00017 with

fifteen (15) conditions.
