Ordinance To Amend And Re-Enact The Zoning Ordinance Of The City Of Hampton, Virginia by Amending Section 2-2 Entitled, "Definitions" To Add a Definition of Short-term Rental WHEREAS, the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice so require; BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia that Chapter 2 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hampton, Virginia, be amended and re-enacted as follows: **Chapter 2- DEFINITIONS** Sec. 2-2. - Definitions. Bed and breakfast 1. A building or portion thereof containing not more than nine (9) sleeping rooms, in which room and board or room are offered to transient residents. Bed and Breakfast 2. A building or portion thereof containing not more than nine (9) sleeping rooms, in which room and board or room are offered to transient residents, and in which events may be held. Short-term rental. The provision of a room or space that is suitable or intended for occupancy for dwelling, sleeping, or lodging purposes to transient residents in exchange for a charge for the occupancy. This term does not include hotel, bed and breakfast 1, or bed and breakfast 2, as defined within this ordinance.
