NARRATIVE

Grundland Park was acquired in 1967 by the City of Hampton and assigned the default use of R-13. Subsequent large area re-zoning changed the use to R-33. In that a grant to improve and develop a portion of the park was received from the Commonwealth of Virginia's Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) and resulted in a City of Hampton Council Meeting (May 14, 2003) resolution "that the City of Hampton shall dedicate the metes and bounds of the Grundland Park Project properties, in perpetuity, for public outdoors recreation purposes", it is appropriate to re-zone this parcel the same as other large public parks in the City of Hampton.
