Section 8-4	2 DT-1 District – Downtown Business.
(2)	Development and lot size standards. (a) Permitted retail sales, services, and office uses shall be conducted wholly within an enclosed building except for: (i) Bank, with drive-through (ii) Boat sales; (iii) Gas station; (iv) Outdoor dining, downtown; (v) Parking lot; (vi) Restaurant, including drive-through (vii) Rummage sale, temporary; (viii) Those uses authorized by a Special Event Permit issued pursuant to the Hampton City Code; (ix) Seasonal sales authorized by Section 34-7 of the City Code; (x) Food truck host sites; and (xi) Outdoor play areas associated with Day Care 1, Commercial and Day Care 2, Commercial which shall be permitted only within a physically defined and fenced area that is shown on the site plan-; and (xii) Outdoor recreation areas associated with a physical recreational facility.
Section 8-4	3 DT-2 District – Downtown Waterfront.
(2)	Development and lot size standards. (a) Permitted retail sales, services, and office uses shall be conducted wholly within an enclosed building except for:

- (i) Bank, with drive-through
- (ii) Boat repair;
- (iii) Boat sales;
- (iv) Gas station;
- (v) Outdoor dining, downtown;
- (vi) Parking lot;
- (vii) Restaurant, including drive-through
- (viii) Rummage sale, temporary;
- (ix) Those uses authorized by a Special Event Permit issued pursuant to the Hampton City Code;
- (x) Seasonal sales authorized by Section 34-7 of the City Code;
- (xi) Food truck host sites; and
