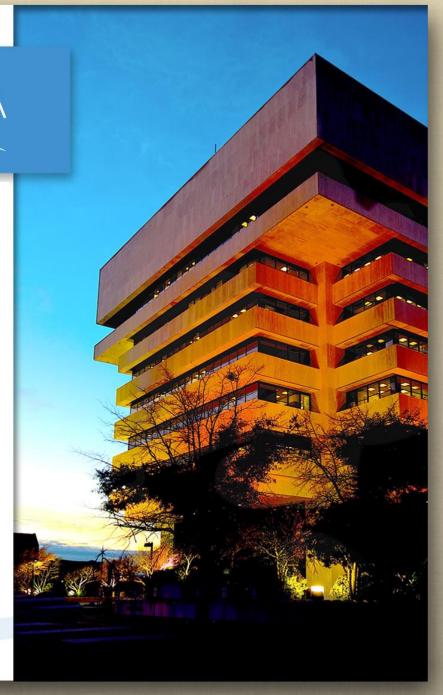

Zoning Ordinance Amendments No. 24-0152, 24-0153, 24-0154, 24-0155, and 24-0156

> Chapters 2, 3, 6, 8, and 9 Private Schools, Physical Recreational Facilities

#### Amendment

To amend Chapters 2, 3, 6, 8, and 9 to permit "Private School" in the Light Manufacturing (M-2) and Heavy Manufacturing (M-3) Districts, to define "Physical Recreational Facility" and add it as a permitted use in multiple districts, to add additional standards to outdoor recreation areas associated with a Physical Recreational Facility, and to permit outdoor recreation areas associated with physical recreational facilities in multiple districts.

## Background

- The definition of private schools is broad and captures many business activities, for example:
  - K-12 schools
  - Welding and other trade schools
  - Dance studios
  - Martial arts studios
- Private schools are permitted in many but not all zoning districts with the approval of a Use Permit

# Background

#### Under the current language:

- Welding or other trade schools are considered private schools and not permitted in the appropriate districts, such as manufacturing
- Dance schools and martial arts studios are considered private schools and require a Use Permit
- Gyms are considered general retail and permitted by right in most districts

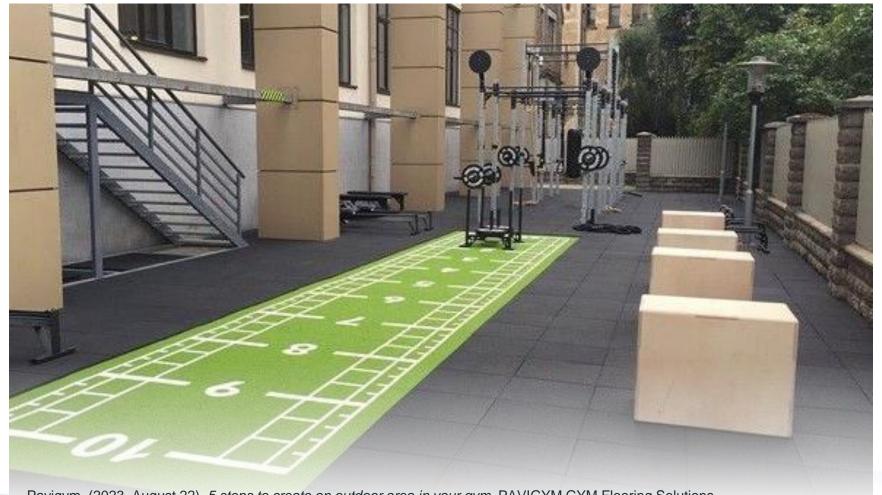
### **Proposed Amendments**

- Permits private schools with a Use Permit within Manufacturing zoning districts (M-2 and M-3) such as welding or trade schools
- Creates the use: physical recreational facilities Includes: martial arts, dance studios, and gyms
- Permits physical recreational facilities by-right in most districts
  - Creates standards for outdoor recreational areas

#### **Proposed Amendments**

# Summary of the additional standards for outdoor recreation area:

- Not permitted within M-1, M-2, LFA-2, LFA-4, LFA-6, HRC-1, and HRC-2
- Meet building setbacks, where applicable
- Have the area delineated through fencing or landscaping
- Be limited on hours if near residential use or districts
- Be screened if near residential use or districts

#### **Proposed Amendments**

Permit "Private School" in the M-2 and M-3 Districts with a Use Permit (Chapter 3)

Define "Physical Recreational Facility" (Chapter 2)

Permit new use "Physical Recreational Facility" in multiple districts with additional standards (Chapter 3)

Add outdoor recreation areas associated with a "Physical Recreational Facility" to the list of permitted outdoor uses in the C-1, DT-1, DT-2, and O-CC Districts (Chapter 6, 8, and 9)
