- WHEREAS: The Planning Commission has before it this day a proposal by the City of Hampton, <u>Plan Amendment No. 012-2007 Kecoughtan Road</u> <u>Corridor Master Plan</u> to amend the <u>Hampton Community Plan</u>, February 2006 by amending the Sunset Creek Area of the <u>Kecoughtan Road Corridor Master Plan</u>; and
- **WHEREAS:** The requested action is to amend the Plan by removing the Thornette Street parking illustration No. 4 from the Sunset Creek Area recommendation and by deleting the related text under subtitle "Eason Park and Darling Stadium" on page 32; and
- **WHEREAS:** The parking recommendation was erroneously left in the final document; and
- **WHEREAS:** The corresponding text related to this illustration under subtitle Eason Park and Darling Stadium reads as follows:

"In addition to the Legion field parking area, the Plan recommends a single row of parking on the northern edge of this Stadium, a small parking lot at Kecoughtan Road and Thornette Street, and increasing the parking capacity at Eason Park."; and

WHEREAS: The revised amended Eason Park and Darling Stadium text would read as follows:

"In addition to the Legion field parking area, the Plan recommends a small parking lot at Kecoughtan Road and Thornette Street and increasing the parking at Eason Park."; and

- **WHEREAS:** The proposed plan amendment was fully supported by the residents of the 300 and 400 Blocks of Thornette Streets and Newport Avenue at a community meeting on Wednesday, April 11, 2007; and
- **WHEREAS:** No members of the public appeared before the Commission providing any support or any opposition to the plan amendment.
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, on a motion made by Commissioner Charles Sapp, and seconded by Commissioner Andre McCloud.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hampton Planning Commission respectfully recommends to the Honorable City Council to amend the <u>Hampton Community</u> <u>Plan</u>, by amending the <u>Kecoughtan Road Corridor Master Plan</u>. A roll call vote on the motion resulted as follows:
