

1 **Ordinance to Amend and Reenact the City Code of the City of Hampton, Virginia by**  
2 **Amending Chapter 2, Administration, Article I, In General, Sec. 2-2 to Establish**  
3 **Removal Procedures for Members of Boards, Commissions, etc.**

5 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia, that Section 2-2  
6 Article I, Chapter 2 of the City Code of the City of Hampton, Virginia be amended to read  
7 as follows:

9 **Chapter 2 – ADMINISTRATION**

10 **Article I – IN GENERAL**

14 **Sec. 2-2. – Residence requirements for members of boards, commissions, etc.;**  
15 ***removal procedures.***

17 **(a)** Except as otherwise provided by the general laws of the state, or Hampton City  
18 Code, any person appointed to a committee, board, commission, authority or similar body,  
19 by the city council must be a resident of the city, unless such body is multijurisdictional or  
20 regional in nature.

21 **(b)** *Except as otherwise provided by the general laws of the state, any person*  
22 *appointed to a committee, board, commission, authority or similar body by the city council,*  
23 *may be removed for cause by formal vote of the city council, provided that such member*  
24 *first be given notice of the city council's intention to vote on their removal.*

25 **(c)** *Failure of a person appointed to a committee, board, commission, authority or*  
26 *similar body by the city council, to attend at least 75 percent of the regularly scheduled*  
27 *meetings of the body to which they are appointed, within a one-year period, shall*  
28 *automatically constitute cause for removal. For the purposes of this section, the first one-*  
29 *year period shall run from date of the person's initial appointment to that body, and*  
30 *continue to be calculated based on that date until the person is no longer a member.*
