- 17 Except as otherwise provided by the general laws of the state, or Hampton City
- Code, any person appointed to a committee, board, commission, authority or similar body, 18
- by the city council must be a resident of the city, unless such body is multijurisdictional or 19
- 20 regional in nature.
- Except as otherwise provided by the general laws of the state, any person 21 (b)
- appointed to a committee, board, commission, authority or similar body by the city council, 22
- may be removed for cause by formal vote of the city council, provided that such member 23
- 24 first be given notice of the city council's intention to vote on their removal.
- 25 Failure of a person appointed to a committee, board, commission, authority or
- similar body by the city council, to attend at least 75 percent of the regularly scheduled 26
