adopted the Virginia Erosion and Stormwater Management Regulation, which required local governments to consolidate their

stormwater management and erosion control ordinances;

WHEREAS: on September 11, 2024, in order to comply with the above-

mentioned regulation, City Council adopted the Stormwater

Management and Erosion Control ("SMEC") Ordinance;

WHEREAS: in adopting the SMEC Ordinance, City Council repealed City Code

Chapter 13.1 – Land Distubing Operations and City Code Chapter 33.2 – Stormwater Management, and further adopted and enacted City Code Chapter 33.3 – Stormwater Management and

Erosion Control;

WHEREAS: the proposed City Code Amendment removes cross-references in

the Subdivision Ordinance to former City Code Chapters 13.1 and 33.2, and replaces them with cross-references to new City Code

Chapter 33.3;

WHEREAS: no comments or questions were raised by the Commissioners

regarding this amendment; and

WHEREAS: no members from the public spoke during the public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City

Council approval of City Code Amendment No. 24-0467.
