

1 **Ordinance to Amend and Reenact Section 24-39.1 of the City Code of the City of**  
2 **Hampton, Virginia, Entitled, “Open Storage of Inoperable Vehicles on Property**  
3 **Zoned For Other Than Residential Purposes” Pertaining to the Applicability of that**  
4 **Section to New Vehicle Sales**

5 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Hampton, Virginia that Section 24-39.1 of the City  
6 Code of the City of Hampton, Virginia, be amended and re-enacted as follows:

19 *(h) The provisions of this section shall not apply to a property or parcel of land where the*  
20 *primary use of such property or parcel of land is “vehicle sales, new inventory lot” and an*  
21 *accessory use of such property or parcel of land is either “vehicle repair, heavy” or “vehicle*  
22 *repair, light” as those terms are defined in Section 2-2 of the Zoning Ordinance.*
