16	(1)	Intent. The principal purposes of the PO-1 District are:
17	,	(a) To conserve and protect open space, natural environmental features, and
18		wildlife habitat;
19		(b) To enhance the quality of life with provision of space for walking, passive
20		and active recreation, and aesthetic enjoyment; and
21		(c) To provide for recreational opportunities, where appropriate.
22		Designating these areas as such will raise the degree of assurance that

24		identify those parcels, relate them to the land use element of the city's adopted
