

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, MARCH 2, 2017 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day a request by Jeffrey Moore to operate Live Entertainment 2 in conjunction with a restaurant at 2080 Nickerson Boulevard [LRSN: 11003251];

WHEREAS: the property is zoned Neighborhood Commercial (C-1) District with proffers which allow for live entertainment with an approved use permit;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) recommends commercial land use for this site. The Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) also promotes nurturing small and start-up businesses, business attraction, and retention. Expanding tourism, entertainment, and cultural opportunities within the city is also a policy recommendation in the City's comprehensive plan;

WHEREAS: staff recommends twelve (12) conditions be attached to the use permit addressing, among other things: issuance of permit ensuring the permit could only apply to the subject property, location of the live entertainment, hours of operation, capacity, sound, dancing, and adequate staffing; and

WHEREAS: one member of the public spoke against this proposal during the public hearing; citing a negative incident in the parking lot of their prior location.

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Carlton Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Christopher Carter,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Use Permit Application No. 16-00010, subject to twelve (12) conditions.
