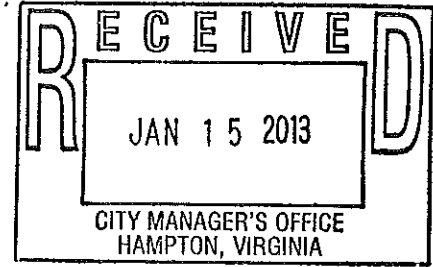

Re: Discount for Medicaid passengers

Dear Ms. Bunting:

We, the Hampton Taxicab Companies, are recommending a change to the City Code regarding taxicab transportation provided for Medicaid recipients. As Medicaid medical transportation demand increases with the aging demographics, budgetary considerations become paramount. We want the option to offer a modest decrease in fare rate to Medicaid riders as is currently available to the elderly and handicapped citizens in Hampton.

The current code states that discounts are only available for elderly and handicapped individuals.

Sec. 38-127. - General rates prescribed; charging different rates.

- (a) The schedule of rates set out in this section shall be charged and collected for the transportation of passengers by a taxicab operating under a certificate granted pursuant to this article. No different rate shall at any time be charged or collected for such services, except for such discounts as are granted to certain qualifying elderly or handicapped citizens by certain participating taxicab companies.

Our recommendation is to simply add Medicaid recipients to the code.


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


