

AT A PUBLIC HEARING IN A REGULAR MEETING OF THE HAMPTON PLANNING COMMISSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, HAMPTON, VIRGINIA, ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2015 AT 3:30 P.M.

WHEREAS: the Hampton Planning Commission has before it this day a proposal by Elvie Wilson for Live Entertainment 2 inside a restaurant located at 1565 Briarfield Road [LRSN 3005371];

WHEREAS: the property is zoned Neighborhood Commercial (C-1) District, which allows for Live Entertainment 2 in conjunction with a restaurant subject to approval of a use permit;

WHEREAS: the Hampton Community Plan (2006, as amended) recommends commercial use of this property and provides policies calling for safeguarding residential neighborhoods, promoting community interaction, nurturing small businesses, and expanding entertainment opportunities;

WHEREAS: staff recommended thirteen (13) conditions be attached to the use permit addressing hours of operation, location of live entertainment, staffing, noise, parking, and review;

WHEREAS: discussion focused on impacts of the currently permitted use and proposed use to the adjacent Mallory Apartments;

WHEREAS: eleven members of the public spoke in opposition to the use and 78 signed letters were submitted opposing the use;


NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner LaRue,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hampton Planning Commission recommends to City Council approval of Use Permit Application No. 15-00014, subject to thirteen (13) conditions.
